

## 2019 Tennessee History Day FAQs

### Who can compete in Tennessee History Day?

The first and second place medalists at each regional contest qualify for the state contest. The third place medalist is the alternate. If a finalist drops out, we will inform the alternate immediately. Please do not besiege our office with phone calls and emails asking if a space has opened up for you. We will let you know as soon as we do.

### When is Tennessee History Day?

Sat., Apr. 13, 2019.

### What time should I be there?

### Where should I go?

Registration takes place in Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L. Parks, Nashville, TN 37219. The accessible entrance is from Rosa L. Parks onto the 2<sup>nd</sup> Fl. The building can also be entered from 7<sup>th</sup> Ave N onto the 3<sup>rd</sup> Fl (not accessible).

The Opening Ceremony and Awards Ceremony will take place in War Memorial Auditorium, 301 6th Ave N, Nashville, TN 37243. The accessible entrance is at the south end of the building, onto the ground floor. Look for the Vietnam Veterans' statue.

Competition rounds will take place in Tennessee Tower and Nashville Public Library.

### Where should I park?

State Parking Lot (Free)  
Corner of Charlotte Ave and 10th Cir. N.

Nashville Public Library (\$14 max)  
Enter from either 6th Ave N or 7th Ave N.

### How long do I have to stay?

You must attend your interview. Junior Group Performance competitors should plan to stay until 1 pm, when the finalists for the second round will be announced. The Performance final round will last until 2 pm. Exhibit students may leave, but their exhibits must remain for the second round of judging (to be held without the students), which will last until approximately 2 pm. All props and exhibits must be removed from the building by 2:45 pm.

The Awards Ceremony starts at 3 pm and will end around 4:15 pm. Medal winners should plan to stay another 15 or 20 minutes for a meeting about National History Day. The Auditorium should be cleared by 4:30 pm.

### What should I do with my free time between the interview and the Awards Ceremony?

We suggest visiting the new Tennessee State Museum, 1000 Rosa L Parks Blvd, Nashville, TN 37243.

The Nashville Farmers' Market, 900 Rosa L Parks Blvd, Nashville, TN 37208, is a lively destination with an international food court.
